What Is the Trinity?

I. **Who?**

1. The Concept of the TRINITY, or Trinitarianism, is the belief that God (or the Godhead) is made up of THREE distinct persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

II. **Where?**

1. *In the beginning. Genesis 1: 1; 26 NKJV*
2. *In the LIVES of God's servants, prophets, judges, kings, warriors, etc. I Samuel 10:6-7 NLT*
3. *In the promises, prophecies, and EXPECTATIONS of the Messiah. Isaiah 42:1 NIV*
4. *In the lives of Jesus and His followers.*
 - a. Incarnation (John 1:1-4; 14 NIV)
 - b. Birth (Luke 1:35 NIV)
 - c. Baptism (Luke 3:21-22 NIV)
 - d. Teaching to Disciples (John 14:7-11 NKJV)
 - e. Promises to Disciples (John 14:16-17 NLT)
 - f. Words of Disciples (Acts 10:38 NLT)
 - g. Prayers of Disciples (Ephesians 1:16-17 NIV)

III. **Why?**

1. *II Corinthians 13:14 NIV- "May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."*
